Minutes of the meeting for November 22, 2022 Hybrid Meeting hosted by Miss Utility in Hanover, MD Prepared by Susan Sullivan

CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Chairman Kevin Woolbright called the regular monthly meeting to order at 9:32 AM. There were twenty-nine (29) virtual attendees and thirteen (13) onsite attendees.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion to approve the September 27, 2022, was made by Jack Ellison (WGL) and seconded by Angela Johnson (AT&T). The motion carried by approval.

OPEN DISCUSSION

Scott Brown (BOD Chair) introduced Ryan Reece as Washington Gas' new MD/DC Damage Prevention Supervisor. He has extensive experience in locating, damage prevention and damage prevention training. Welcome Ryan!

Tom Reynolds of Commercial Utilities introduced himself as the Safety & Quality Control Director of the company. He gave some history as to his past experiences with Miss Utility which have become much more positive as he has engaged with the Miss Utility team via damage prevention training and attendance at this year's GCDPTC. He looks forward to attending monthly Miss Utility Damage Prevention Meetings and is excited about sharing his newfound awareness and understanding of call center procedures and the role Miss Utility plays in the industry.

Tim Kaptein (Comer) asked about getting Bel Air traffic lights marked as the Town of Bel Air often does not show up on his tickets. Bill Jackson (MDOT) replied that streetlight ownership and marking responsibilities vary throughout the state and to ensure that the Right of Way questions are answered correctly. Becky Mellinger (Childs Landscape) recommended contacting Ben, Signal Shop Supervisor for P.G. County Traffic Lights at 240-602-4022 as he may be able to assistance.

Kevin Woolbright complimented Utiliquest for the fantastic and professional locate completed by a UQ locator working in his neighborhood. Scott Brown followed up by stating that Utiliquest is recognized as the best in the country with Maryland ranking as one of the best for accurate locates.

Mitzi Ambush (Pepco) spoke to damages being caused by contractors using vac trucks especially on 4th St. NW in D.C. She pointed out that contractors should use great caution when using this type of excavation equipment and that even minor damages to any underground facility or conduit requires work to cease and the damage reported. All damages, questions or inquires should be directed to Customer Service at 202-872-2000 (#2). She also complimented Troy Middleton (Utiliquest) and Jason Lewis (USIC) for great partnerships.

Ian Jones (BGE) said the same procedures should be followed per BGE at the same number, as both companies operate under the parent company Exelon.

Bob Kerns (Potomac Edison) complimented USIC and their assistance with ongoing concerns among sub-contractor ticketing and excavating recently experienced in Washington County. After a company conference call with the main company involved, ongoing issues have been minimized.

MISS UTILITY CALL CENTER

- Updates Reported by Jennifer Arroyo (Miss Utility)
 - The Self Select Start Date section of ITICnxt ticketing is being revamped to make it more pronounced and user friendly.
 - Ticket quality and safe excavation are very important. For these reasons, users may receive calls from call center staff regarding concerns or questions pertaining to a processed ticket that may not follow ticketing procedures. Direct release users will be put back into review if concerns about accurate ticketing procedures are not resolved by the user.

 - DE/ESMD: December 2 & 16 (ITICnxt goes live on December 1st)

- ➤ Dashboard Reporting: Jennifer Arroyo provided ticket volume data for the month of October 2022.
 - Inbound ticket volume: 77,250 a monthly decrease of 16.787% compared to 2021
 - Outbound volume: 424,049 a year-to-date decrease of 25.506% compared to 2021
- ➤ Damage Reporting: Susan Sullivan provided YTD data through October 2022 of reported damages in MD/DC.
 - 750 utility damages (178 mains and 572 services)
 - 29.73% due to no call or valid ticket
 - 34.67% due to hitting a marked line
 - 28.80% due to incorrect locate marks
 - 6.80% due to other root causes

MARYLAND AUTHORITY | Jim Barron, Executive Director

- There was an Open Authority Meeting and a Closed Executive Authority Zoom Meeting on October 5, 2021. There was no November meeting.
 - o The Authority reviewed fourteen (14) NPVs.
 - o There are twenty-four (24) new NPVs to investigation and review.
 - o The Authority:
 - Is currently drafting Legislation for the 2023 legislative session,
 - Had a booth and participated in the 2022 Greater Chesapeake Damage Prevention Training Conference in October 2022,
 - Is negotiating with a collection agency to handle unpaid fines recommended by the Authority,
 - Received a perfect 258 score in the 2021 Adequacy Evaluation by PHMSA, and
 - Will resume face-to-face Formal Hearings in February 2023.
- The following Authority Seats expired on September 30, 2022:
 - o AUC of MD Seat David Gaines He will serve his 2nd two-year term,
 - o Subscriber Seat Michael Jewell will be replaced by David Wilkins of WSSC,
 - One Call Seat Kelly Ruddo will be replaced by Jennifer Arroyo of One Call Concepts, and
 - MML Seat Dereck Shreves will be replaced by Michael Beall, DPW Director of the Town of University Park.
 - o New appointees will not be officially appointed until the new Governor is sworn in.

The next meeting will be a Zoom Closed Executive Session on December 7, 2022.

CONSTRUCTION ANGELS

Kevin Woolbright, CA Board Representative for MD/DC

Kevin thanked everyone for their support of Construction Angels this year. As previously reported, there were a total of three Maryland fatalities reported to CA this year. Each family received both monies and CA services. He also thanked Scott Brown and the MD/DC Subscribers and Board Committee as well as Jim Barron and the Maryland Authority for their support and sponsorships.

Kevin has attended various events promoting and educating attendees about Construction Angels and spoke to suggestions presented by various supporters about fund raising ideas. He also participates in monthly CA calls and encourages partnerships with various associations. He also plans to attend the 2023 Con Expo, as a CA representative and where CA will be highlighted. Please contact Kevin for more information about CA or with questions or fundraising ideas.

Scott Brown ended the meeting by emphasizing that monies funded by new legislation will increase not only the number of excavation projects across the country but also the number of damages. He therefore, reminded contractors and excavators to make use of Maryland's Self Select Start Date to reduce spikes in locating and to limit the scope of work per ticket to that which can be completed within the validity period of a Maryland ticket, which is twelve (12) business days starting on the Self Select Start Date. This reduces the number of update tickets created by users because they are unable to complete the work detailed on a given ticket within its validity period. Both reminders are based on Maryland's Title 12 'Dig' Law which can be read in its entirety at:
